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Section 1:

Michael Jackson was conceived in Gary, Indiana on August 19, 1958. Michael's dad, Joe Jackson, acted as a crane administrator at a steel processing plant. Michael was presently one of the greatest stars in music.

Michael sadly passed away of a heart assault on June 25, 2009. He was fifty years of age. The heart attack was likely brought about by medications he was taking to help him rest (George, 2010).
